Position Objective: Effectively teach beginning and intermediate level string students, to meet music standards. Utilize supplementary materials and experiences to enhance student learning. (Current focus of this program is in the middle school.)

Have excellent written and verbal communication skills; organized, and a team player.

Educational and Experience Requirements: Bachelor's degree required. Classroom teaching experience in Christian education preferred. Experience with Google platform. Ability to teach, inspire, and prepare students for traditional and creative performance opportunities.

- Participate in spiritual activities at FBA such as prayer, devotions, Bible study, and chapel as able.
- Support the school's parent organization initiatives as it impacts the classroom and students.
- Complete all reporting duties and other paperwork assigned.

- Hold help classes as needed or requested by students of parents.
- Maintain proper classroom discipline.
- Schedule conferences with parents or students as needed.
- Supervise and/ or lead extra-curricular activities, organizations and outings as assigned.
- Complete all requirements for ACSI certification.
- Maintain a close personal walk with the Lord evidenced by lifestyle.
- Observe the Matthew 18 principle of conflict resolution.
- Fulfill all duties as assigned by the school administration.
- Demonstrate a love for teaching and learning with enthusiasm.
- Maintain a clean, attractive classroom that is conducive to learning.
- Plan and implement biblically integrated lessons.
- Punctual in attendance to faculty meetings, devotions, and all assigned responsibilities.

- Available to assist others as needed, promoting unity.
- Collaborate with teachers for chapels, concerts, and special events.
- Represent and promote FBA Fine Arts in the community.
- Participate in Music Festivals that will benefit FBA Fine Arts students and community.
- Promote the Fine Arts department of FBA.
